KEYING

Key Sections / Keyways

There are three types of Yale key sections.

1. Standard Simplex Keyway - Yale cylinders are supplied with the E1R (PARA) simplex keyway as standard unless otherwise specified.

2. Simplex Keyways - Single keyways which are used for keyed different, keyed alike or small master key systems when only one keyway is required.







3. Surety Keyways - Also referred to as multiplex keyways use a variety of different shaped keyways (the keys will not interchange). The master key section is milled to pass all the different keyways of a particular series. Surety keyways are used on large or complex master key systems.







*The section of the key is determined by viewing the key from the bow towards the tip.
